

These terms and conditions apply when you enter, leave or use the car parks or bicycle and scooter racks provided by the State Sport Centres (SSC) located at the Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre, Lakeside Stadium, State Netball and Hockey Centre or Knox Regional Sports Park (**Venue**).

In this document, references to:

"**car park**" mean the car parks, bicycle and scooter storage cages and bicycle and scooter racks controlled by or on behalf of SSC and used for the parking of vehicles or other purposes, including public car parks and unreserved car parks, or any car parks designated as such by SSCT from time to time;

"**vehicle**" means motorised vehicles, bicycles or scooters;

"**your vehicle**" includes a vehicle driven, or intended to be driven, or a bicycle or scooter ridden, or intended to be ridden, by you into the car park;

"**SSCT**" means the State Sport Centres Trust, trading as the State Sport Centres (ABN 16 374 471 008), and includes its employees, agents and independent contractors.

1. By entering the Venue, car park or using the bicycle or scooter racks, you are deemed to have accepted these terms and conditions.
2. You drive/ride, park and leave your vehicle in the car park subject to the Terms and Conditions of Entry and Use (including these Conditions of Parking and Storage), at your own risk and you remain responsible for your vehicle, its accessories and its contents at all times.
3. Where applicable, you must pay upon demand all parking fees and other costs incurred in relation to your vehicle being in the car park, based on any schedule of fees displayed at the time of entry.
4. SSC may refuse entry to the Venue or car park to any vehicle or person.
5. SSC is not liable, except to extent caused by SSC or otherwise required by law, for:
 - a. any theft, loss, or damage whatsoever to any vehicle, its accessories, or its contents,
 - b. any death or injury of any person,

while you, your vehicle or your property are in the car park or while you are entering or leaving the Venue or car park.

6. You are liable for any damaged caused by you or your vehicle to the Venue or car park including substances that leak from your vehicle.
7. Vehicles entering the car park must comply with:
 - a. all applicable Victorian and Australian laws;
 - b. all signs and directions contained in the car park; and
 - c. all reasonable directions and requests made by SSCT personnel from time to time.
8. You must park within the boundaries of one bay.
9. You must not obstruct any persons or other vehicles or access to them.
10. SSC may move or remove your vehicle at your expense if, in the opinion of SSC, it is parked in an unauthorised or unsafe position, is unregistered or appears to be abandoned, and if SSCT moves your vehicle these conditions continue to apply.
11. SSC reserves the right to retain your vehicle, and all goods in or attached to the vehicle, as security for any money which you owe SSC under these Conditions of Parking and Storage. If you fail to pay any money you owe SSC, SSCT may sell your vehicle in accordance with all applicable legislation.
12. Failure to comply with these Conditions of Parking and Storage may constitute a breach of contract and you may be liable for the payment of penalties or damages.
