

## SSCT TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF GENERAL ENTRY AND USE

The purpose of these Terms and Conditions is to ensure the safety and enjoyment of all visitors, contractors and employees of the State Sport Centres Trust (SSCT), managers of Melbourne Sports & Aquatic Centre, Lakeside Stadium, State Netball and Hockey Centre and the Knox Regional Sports Park (each, a **Venue**). These terms and conditions must be read with any other applicable terms and conditions, which can be found on our website [HERE](#).

- Rules and instructions.** You and any people in your care must comply with any instructions provided by SSCT personnel and comply with all rules and policies displayed in the Venue and on our website. Other terms and conditions may apply, depending on your activities in the Venue.
- Children.** We are a child safe organisation and operate under our [Child Safety and Wellbeing Policy](#). Children under 12 years of age must be accompanied by a person at least 16 years of age to be permitted entry to the Venue.
- Standards of behaviour and attire.** You are not permitted to act in a way that is abusive, threatening or in the SSCT's sole determination, likely to cause nuisance, disruption or offence to others. A non-exhaustive list of prohibited behaviour is on our website [HERE](#). You must wear appropriate clothing when attending a Venue in line with our [Suitable Attire Policy](#).
- Prohibited items.** Certain items are not permitted to be brought into the Venue. For example, bicycles, scooters, incendiary devices, or objects that may be used as a weapon. A non-exhaustive list of prohibited items is on our website [HERE](#). SSCT reserves the right to inspect any bag, luggage or object upon entry to and before leaving the Venue. Animals, except assistance animals, are not permitted in the Venue.
- Smoking and alcohol.** Smoking, including use of electronic cigarettes, is not permitted in the Venue, or within ten metres of a Venue. Alcoholic beverages cannot be taken into or from the Venue. You will not be admitted to the Venue or an activity if we consider that you are under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- Safety.** You must take reasonable care for your own safety and the safety of people in your care. We will follow our procedures in the event of an emergency or incident. If this requires us to call for medical assistance, including an ambulance, you will be responsible for all associated costs.
- Personal belongings.** We accept no responsibility for loss, damage to or theft of any personal belongings (including but not limited to wallets, phones or vehicles) that you bring to the Venue. We strongly recommend that you do not bring valuables with you. If you do, we recommend that you secure them safely. Parking of vehicles, including cars, bicycles and scooters, at a Venue is subject to our [Parking Terms and Conditions](#).
- Risk and liability.** There are risks that can present within SSCT facilities relating to your use of SSCT facilities, participation in any program and presence at the Venue. You enter the Venue at your own risk. Subject to any rights you may have under law, we and any of our officers, employees and agents accept no liability for any loss or damage to property, injury or death which may occur at the Venue. To the full extent permitted by law, you release and discharge SSCT from all liabilities and claims arising out of your use of the Venue or SSCT facilities.
- Privacy.** You consent to the SSCT's collection, use and management of personal information according to the [SSCT Privacy Policy](#).
- Filming and photography.** You may use cameras, video recorders or any other recording device in the Venue respectfully, for your personal use only and for a lawful purpose, subject to our [Filming and Photography Policy](#). Filming or photography is not permitted in changerooms and toilets.
- Commercial filming.** With our approval, certain events and activities are filmed by venue hirers according to relevant rules and policies. Please be aware of signage indicating when filming is occurring.
- CCTV.** You consent to being monitored, filmed and photographed at the Venue. We use these images for purposes related to the maintenance, operation and security of the Venue subject to our [CCTV Policy](#).
- Marketing.** You consent to being filmed, televised, photographed and otherwise recorded by us or by others when in the Venue. We have the right to reproduce, use or license the use of these material as we see fit without your further approval being required. Where marketing material involves children, the parents/carers and child will be provided opportunity to withhold or withdraw consent under our [Child Safety and Wellbeing Policy](#).
- Changes in Venue.** We reserve the right to close the Venue or change the way patrons are permitted to use the Venue. We may also impose directions we consider necessary to comply with any government advice or for health, safety or security reasons.

**Breach of these conditions or failure to follow our instructions.** If you breach these terms and conditions or fail to follow our rules, instructions and policies, we may refuse entry, require you to immediately leave the Venue or require you not return to the Venue for a specific period of time and you will not be entitled to a refund or compensation of any kind. Any breach that constitutes a criminal offence, may be reported to the relevant authorities such as Victoria Police.
